on their absolute position after the sixth round.

The World Adventure Golf Tour organisation does not take any form of payment either from the participating players or from the Minigolf

Federation. All services are provided for free.

**Categories** The categories are Men and Women.

**Teams** There will be a Team competition organised exclusively by Federação

Portuguesa de Minigolfe.

Teams must be made up of four players in the same minigolf club.

As all players will be competing in all six of the tournaments rounds, the WAGT Ranking Points and category winners will be decided at the end of the tournament.

Depending on how many people register, it might not be possible to re-order the groups between Rounds 5 and 6. This will be announced on Sunday morning before Round 4.

**Training** Training on Friday at 9am-6pm before the tournament is included in

> the price. On this Friday the course will be closed to the public. Players can train on the course on the Monday – Thursday before the Tournament for a special €7 day fee, which should be paid each day

to the course.

To enable people to follow along from the scores at home, and to display realtime scores on the live stream, the Bangolf Arena Mobile

App will be used for Live Scoring.

tournament.

All players are asked to bring to the tournament their mobile phone fully charged. No player should have to score more than 2 rounds.

Scoring In groups of 3 scoring will be done in the following manner:

Player 1 – Uses mobile app

- Player 2 Uses a scorecard and pencil that will be provided
- Player 3 Does a visual check

# **Live Scoring**



### **Rules**

WMF MOS (Adventure Golf) rules will be used. They can be viewed <u>here</u>. In particular please note:

- The bunkers filled with rocks do count as Hazards as part of the MOS Rules. This means that players can either play from the bunker or move the ball back to the location of the previous shot to play the next shot (without penalty). Players are not permitted to give themselves relief from where the ball entered the bunker.
- The tee-off positions are shown at the end of this document
- There are some locations where the lane has a rock close to the boundary. In these courses, in order to be allowed relief on the side of the hole, players must fully pass the rock.
  During the opening ceremony we will visit these lanes and explain in more detail.

### **Tee-off Positions**

Imagine a line extending from the front of the tee-off matt. The ball can be placed anywhere on this line, and anywhere behind this line (including the tee-off mat itself).

To visualize this, it means you can place the ball on, or behind, the line in the pictures below:
