WMF World Adventure Golf Tour The WMF World Adventure Golf Tour Final is the culmination of the WMF World Adventure Golf Tour.

- 42 Players will qualify to play the Final
- Winners of the 15 WMF World Adventure Golf Tour Events earn an Automatic Qualification in to the Final
- Tour Sponsors can each nominate one player to play in the Final
- 3 spaces are reserved for the women with the most Ranking Points in the 24/25 Season
- After this, [this table](#), of Ranking Points in the 25/26 Season will be used to make up the 42 total players. Those with the highest Ranking Points in the 25/26 Season will be invited first

De-registration If you have registered for the WMF World Adventure Golf Tour Final and your plans change, you must deregister [here](#).

If you fail to de-register up to **two weeks** before the Final, or fail to present viable evidence for the last-minute cancellation in the last two weeks before the Final, and do not attend the Final, you will be banned from competing in the next WMF World Adventure Golf Tour Final.

Once a player de-registers, the player with the next highest Ranking Points (who has previously registered) will be informed that they have qualified to play in the Final.

Format In randomly drawn groups of three, players will play five traditional rounds of stroke play.

At the end of these five rounds, the best 16 players will qualify for the final stage and be assigned a **Seed number** based on their total score (the person with the lowest score will be assigned #1 Seed and so on). If there is a tie for #16 Seed, a sudden death playoff will be held. If there is a tie for any other Seed, the player with the most Ranking Points will be awarded the lower Seed number (in the case where tied players have the same amount of Ranking Points, the seeding will be assigned randomly).

Players will be sorted into a knock-out bracket according to:

In this bracket players will face off in head-to-head single round match play based on strokes. This means, that at the end of each single round, the player with the fewer total strokes over 18 Lanes will advance and the other player will be eliminated. If there is a tie between the two players after a single round, a sudden death tie breaker beginning from Lane 1 will be held to see who advances.

Players keep their same seed number all the way throughout the knock-out bracket. The player with the lowest seed number will always start first in each head-to-head round. To put this another way: the player with seed number 16 will always play starting second on lane #1, and the player with seed number 1 will always play starting first on lane #1. After that the playing order will rotate each lane.

At the end of this bracket there will be a Final Round. The winner will become champion of the WMF World Adventure Golf Tour 2025/26.

Play-offs All play-offs will take place starting from Lane 1

Gloucester Garden Centre Please note, Aces Minigolf operates within Gloucester Garden Centre players and spectators must follow their rules and polices. There is a café and restaurant on site.

Pace of Play Players must play each stroke within 60 seconds according to the WMF rules. The 60 seconds begin for the first stroke when the previous player has completed the lane, and for the following strokes right after the completion of the previous stroke.

For both the Semi-Final and Final Rounds, a 60 second shot timer will be enforced by the Referees. Failure to hit a stroke within the 60 second timer will result in an automatic extra stroke being awarded.

Training Training is available starting today.

There is a special training fee of £10 (€11.50) per day. This should be paid at the start of each day at the cabin.

There is free training on Wednesday (29th Apr) and Thursday (30th Apr) where the course will be closed to the public.

Registration Fee There is no registration fee for entering the Final.

Prizes The Prize Pot is currently a minimum of €7,000. Prizes are awarded as follows

 Winner - €3,000 and WMF World Adventure Golf Tour Trophy
 Runner Up - €1,500
 Losing Semi Finalists - €750
 Losing Quarter Finalists - €250

Aces Gloucester Strokeplay Prize	The Aces Gloucester course has generously donated a strokeplay prize. This is to be awarded after the strokeplay as follows
1st - €600	
2nd - €400	
3rd - €250	
4th - €150	
5th - €100	

Note that the award of the strokeplay prize has no impact on the rest of the competition. It is a special one-off prize that will be awarded after the 5th and final round of strokeplay.

If any players are tied for these positions, then the prize money will be split accordingly. In other words, the only potential play-off that will happen after strokeplay is for the 16th position.

If a player is awarded a strokeplay prize and a Tournament prize, then these two prizes will be combined. For example: if a player comes second in the strokeplay and wins the Tournament they will be awarded €3,400 total.

Live Scoring	To enable people to follow along from the scores at home, and to display realtime scores on the live stream, the Bangolf Arena Mobile App will be used for Live Scoring.

All players are asked to bring to the tournament their mobile phone **fully charged**. No player should have to score more than 2 rounds.

Scoring	In groups of 3 scoring will be done in the following manner:

- Player 1 – Uses mobile app
- Player 2 – Uses a scorecard and pencil that will be provided
- Player 3 – Does a visual check

Rules	WMF Adventuregolf rules (Rulebook chapter 2.7) will be used. They can be viewed here . Course specific rules will be shared during the Technical meeting.
Coaching	Players are permitted to ask for advice and guidance within their playing group only. Players are not permitted to ask or receive any kind of coaching from outside their playing group. According to the WMF sport rules, leaving your playing group for coaching actions is not allowed. According to the rules it is possible to penalize both the coaching player and the coached player.
Referees	Tournament Director Pasi Aho will act as supervisor of the tournament.
Spectators	Spectators are encouraged throughout the Tournament. In particular for the Semi-Final and Final Rounds (that are played individually). Spectators are invited on to the course, keeping a respectful distance, to cheer on their favourite players.
Approved Balls	WMF-approved golf and minigolf balls are permitted to be used in this Tournament. Various players have contacted the World Adventure Golf Tour association asking for guidance on which Minigolf balls to use.
